

REGULATIONS DaKINO INTERNATIONAL FILM FESTIVAL

The 25th edition of DaKINO International Film Festival will take place 13th to 17th April 2016, in Bucharest, Romania.

The Festival is an annual event, competitive, non-specialized, organized by the FAMart Association and the DaKINO Foundation.

The Festival has a Short Fiction and Animation Competition.

** there is no submission fee*

** the prizes will be awarded by an international Jury*

General conditions:

1. Only films that meet the following conditions will be accepted for selection:

- the film is produced after January 1st 2015;
- the film does not exceed 20 minutes in length;
- the film is subtitled in English, unless the dialogue is in English.

2. Submissions for selection within the DaKINO 25 Competition are open February 20th to March 20th. The shorts will enter the final competition based on a selection put forward by film critic Irina-Margareta Nistor.

3. The screening will be made from either DCP or digital HD files complying with the technical specifications issued by the Festival.

4. The Festival invites one representative of each film accepted in the competition (director/ producer/ writer/ actor) to the Festival, with costs related to accommodation (3 nights) covered by the Festival.

For submitting the film for the DaKINO Competition:

- **via e-mail, at office@famart.ro by March 20th, including:**

- The filled-in entry form
- An online viewing link for the film
- The dialogue list
- A still from the film

- **by regular mail:**

- a DVD of the film- with the title of the film, the director's name and the running time of the film written directly on the DVD.

The DVD will be sent with the following mention: "No commercial value. For cultural purpose only".

The DVD will not be returned.

Film shipping

The screening material should reach the Festival **March 30th at the latest**. In case the material is not sent in due time, the film will be replaced.

The screening material will be sent to the Festival prepaid by the contributor.

The screening material will be sent together with a proforma invoice by normal post or by courier with the following mention: "No commercial value. For cultural purpose only".

The value on the invoice should not exceed 10 Euro.

Films sent by air cargo will not be accepted due to custom procedure difficulties.

3. The Festival has the right to screen the films in competition four times during the Festival.
4. The Festival has the right to use parts of the films in competition for promotion (maximum 3').
